

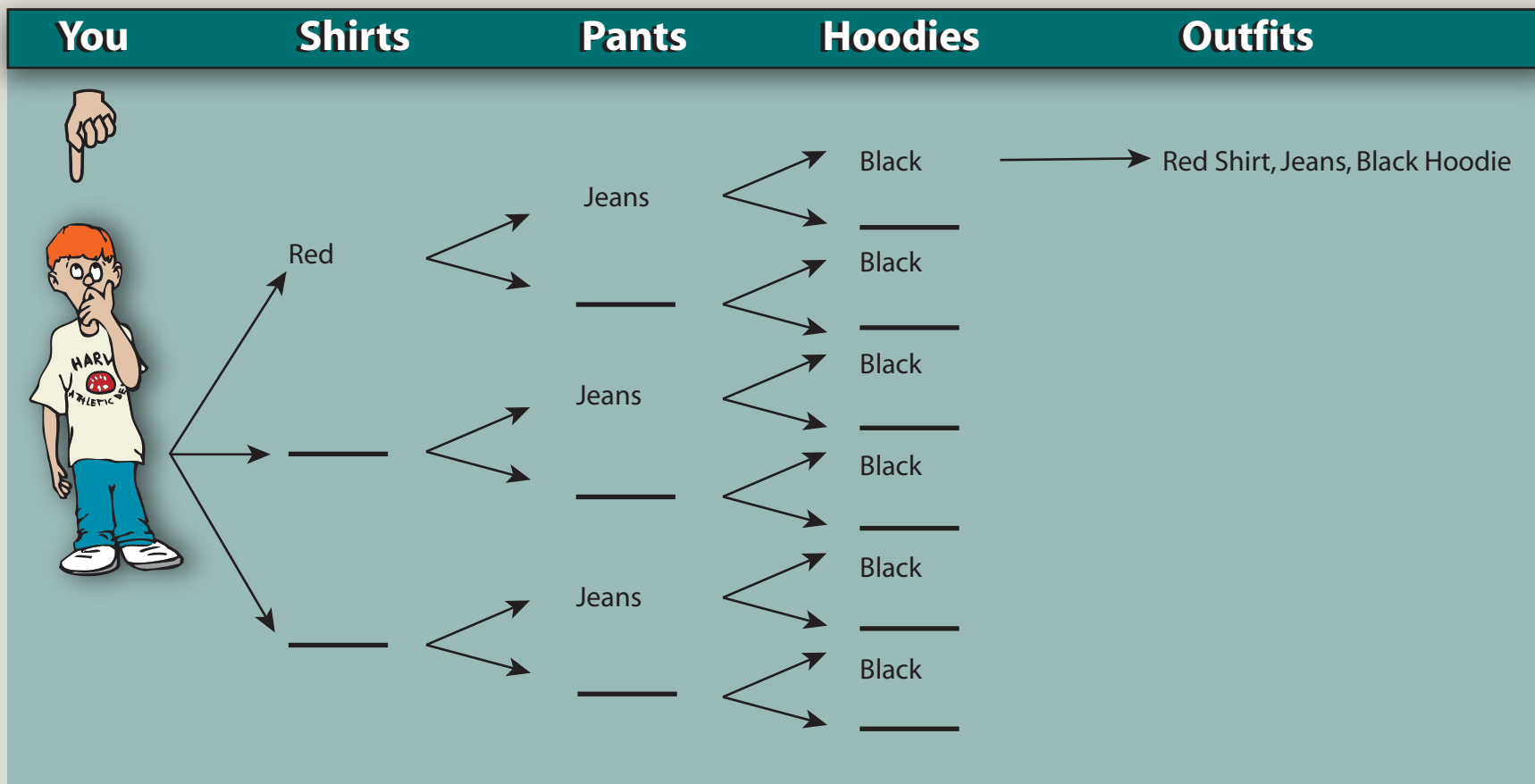
SUITCASE SQUEEZE

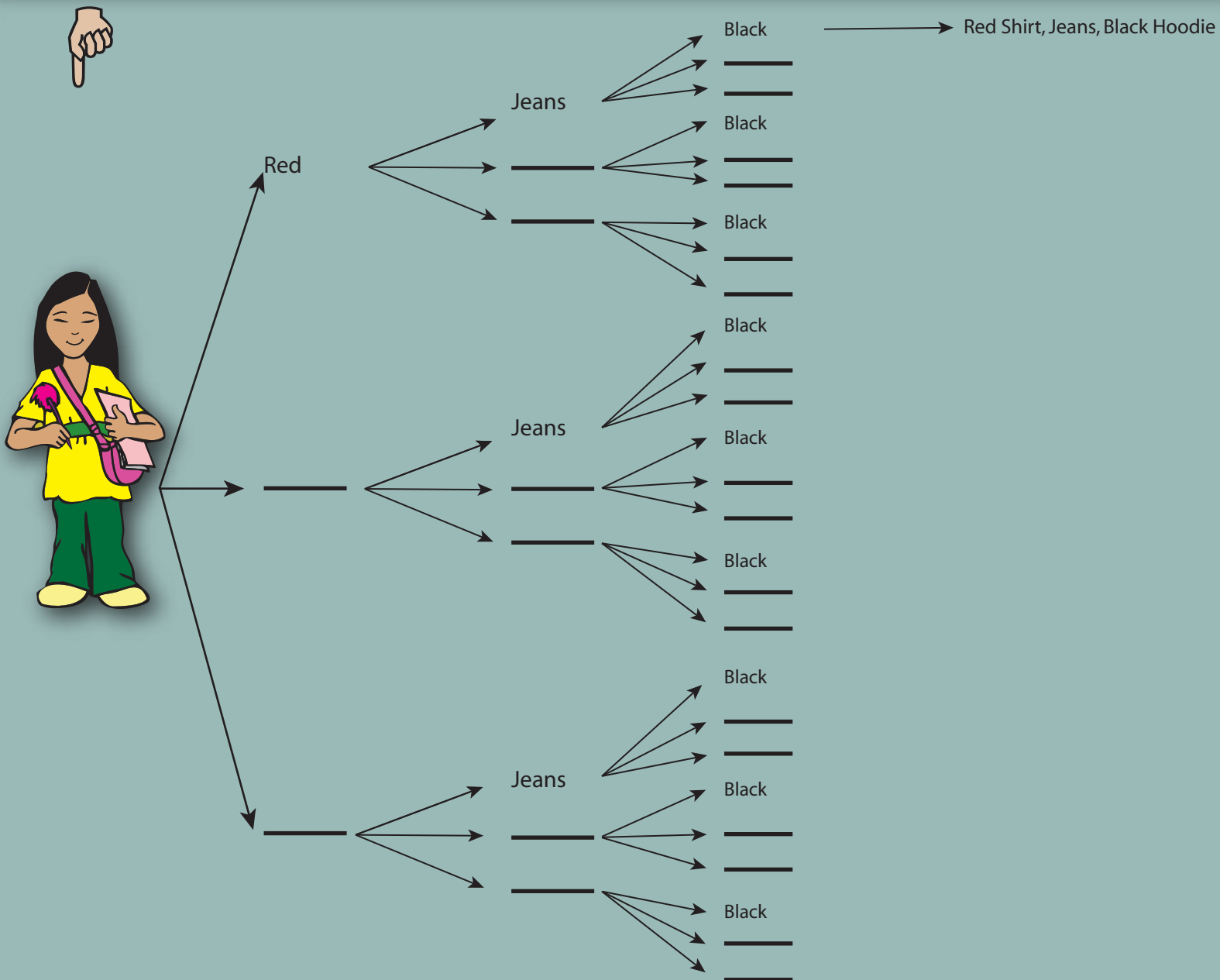

Challenge: You have room in your suitcase for some additional clothes, a pair of black pants and a white hoodie. How many outfits can you make now? Do you think it will be under 20 or over 20? Make a tree diagram and find out.
